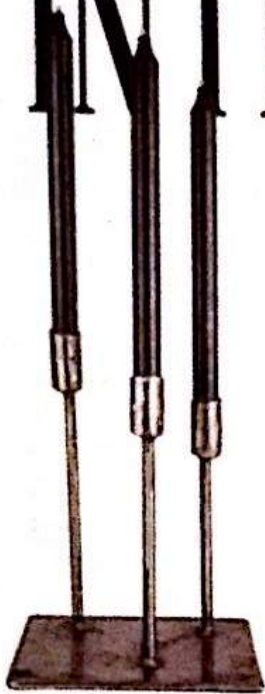

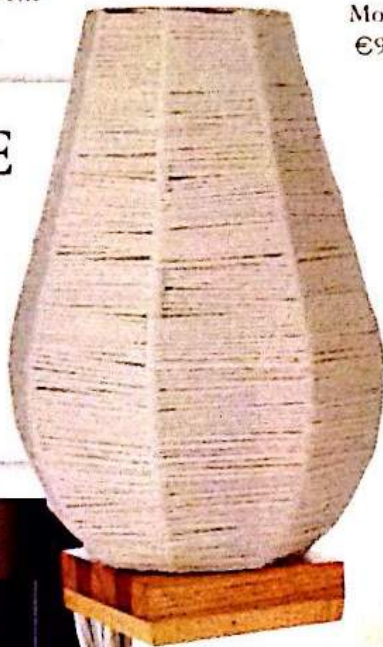


KELLY'S HEROES
